The Forest Preserve District of Kane County offers a Memorial Tree & Bench Program for those who wish to contribute to the beauty of the forest preserves by purchasing a tree to be planted or a bench to be installed in someone's honor or memory.

MEMORIAL TREE DONATION

A memorial tree is a long-lasting opportunity to honor or remember a loved one. At the same time, it improves the beauty and quality of the Kane County Forest Preserves. The Forest Preserve District has chosen native oak trees to be included in the memorial program. Depending on availability, specific trees available for selection include:

- Bur Oak
- Red Oak
- White Oak

Trees will be planted in spring, or at the District's discretion, according to recommendations for a particular species. When planted, trees are 2"-3" in diameter. **The deadline for memorial tree orders is April 1.**

You may select a specific forest preserve for your tree donation. The tree's exact location will be determined by District staff. Memorial trees will be planted adjacent to trails or near parking lots within a chosen preserve.

Donors will be notified once a tree has been planted, and will be made aware of its location. Due to liability, visitors are not allowed to be present during the planting of trees. Donors are not permitted to add additional plantings, flowers or decorations to the memorial's area. You may choose a memorial tree with or without an accompanying brick marker.

The cost for a memorial tree with an accompanying laser-engraved memorial brick marker is \$600. This fee includes:

- Planting of the tree
- A laser-engraved 8" x 8" brick inset at the foot of the tree, surrounded by concrete for stability
- Optional notification of your donation to the honoree's family

The cost for a memorial tree without an accompanying marker is \$400.

This fee includes:

- Planting of the tree
- Optional notification of your donation to the honoree's family

MEMORIAL BENCH DONATION

Memorial benches provide another option to honor or remember a loved one, as well as offer respite to forest preserve visitors to help enjoy the surrounding nature.

Benches may be installed at any time, weather permitting. Donors will be notified once the bench and marker have been installed, and will be made aware of its location. Due to liability, visitors are not allowed to be present during installation of benches. All benches will be installed adjacent to trails or near parking lots within a chosen preserve. Donors are not permitted to add additional plantings, flowers or decorations to the memorial's area.



The cost for a memorial bench is \$1,200. The fee includes:

- Installation of a 6' recycled plastic bench with back, placed on a concrete pad for stability
- Laser-engraved 8" x 8" brick inset at the foot of the bench
- Optional notification of your donation to the honoree's family

LASER-ENGRAVED MEMORIAL BRICK

The clay paver accompanying memorial trees is an 8" x 8" brick surrounded by a concrete frame. For memorial benches, it will be installed in the concrete pad below the bench. For memorial trees, the brick will be installed flush with the ground, near the tree.

Memorial inscriptions are limited to the tree's common name and scientific name, for whom the tree or bench is in honor/memory, and the donor(s). Additional inscriptions, religious symbols and extraneous content is not permitted. There are 6 lines total, with a maximum of 20 characters per line (including spaces or punctuation).

Inscriptions will appear in the following format:

<p>BUR OAK (Quercus Macrocarpa) In memory of John Williams By The Smith Family</p>

Please note, the District will not replace or be responsible for bricks or benches that may become damaged or stolen, or for trees that become damaged or die.
