



Take a Hike Activity Sheet — January Lake Run Forest Preserve

Take the Savannah Knoll Trail to the Mid County Trail, then loop back to the parking lot on the Prairie Trail (total trail length approximately 1 mile). Along this route, you will encounter three interpretive signs. Answer the following questions as you stop and read the signs along your hike.

1. What two human activities have drastically changed the Illinois landscape?
2. Who developed the idea of a land ethic?
3. What has caused the decline of many native Illinois animals?
4. List two examples of animals negatively affected by habitat fragmentation?
5. What shaped the Illinois landscape 13,000 years ago?
6. What did farmers do to wet areas they encountered in Illinois?
7. What is the Forest Preserve District of Kane County currently doing to help change the landscape back to a more natural habitat for the plants and animals of Illinois?

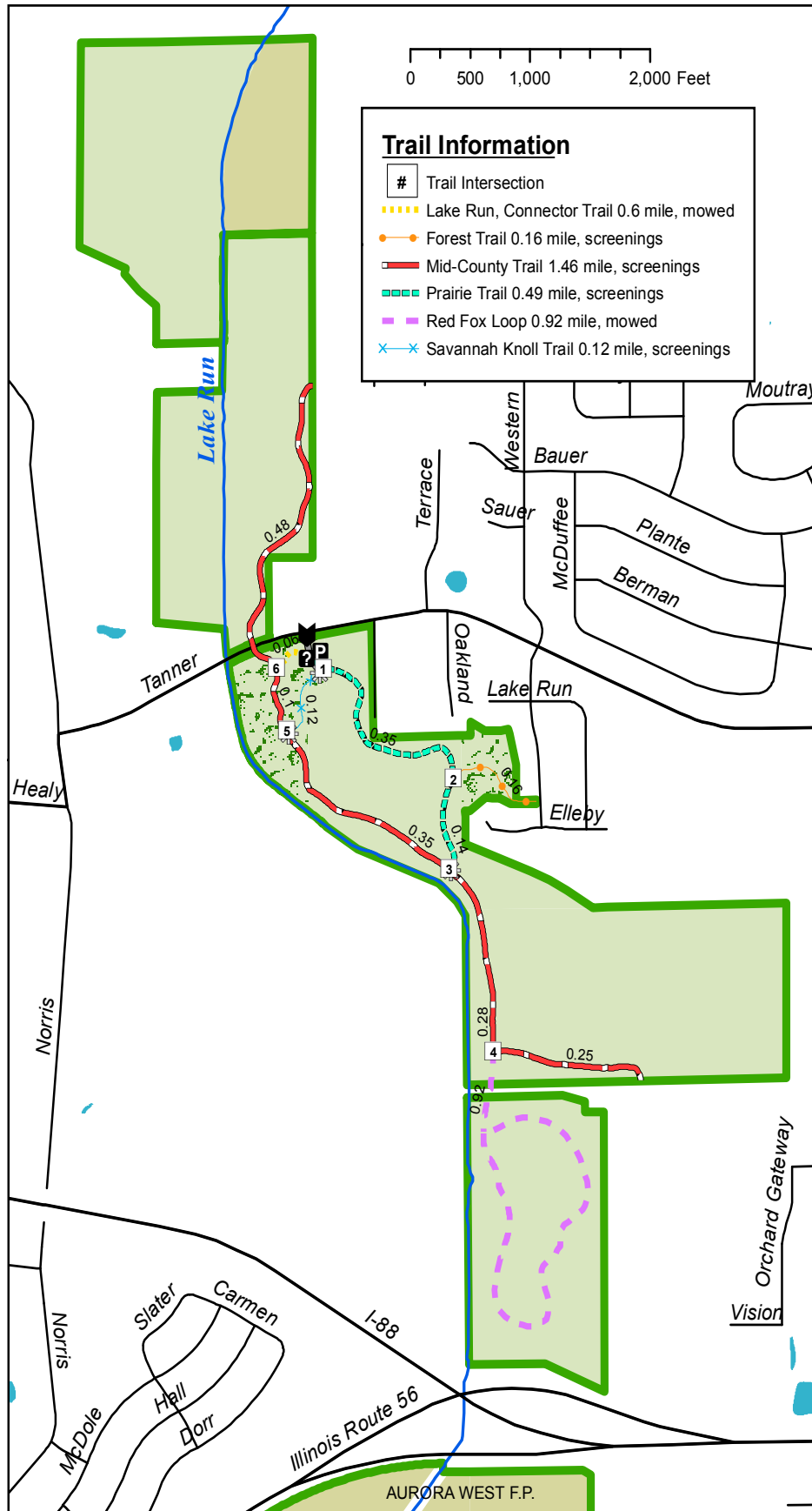
