At the Clam's Eye View of the Fox River exhibit, complete the following activities:

- Find a bird-eating fish
- Find a wading bird
- Find four turtles
- Find something camouflaged
- Count all the birds; how many did you see?

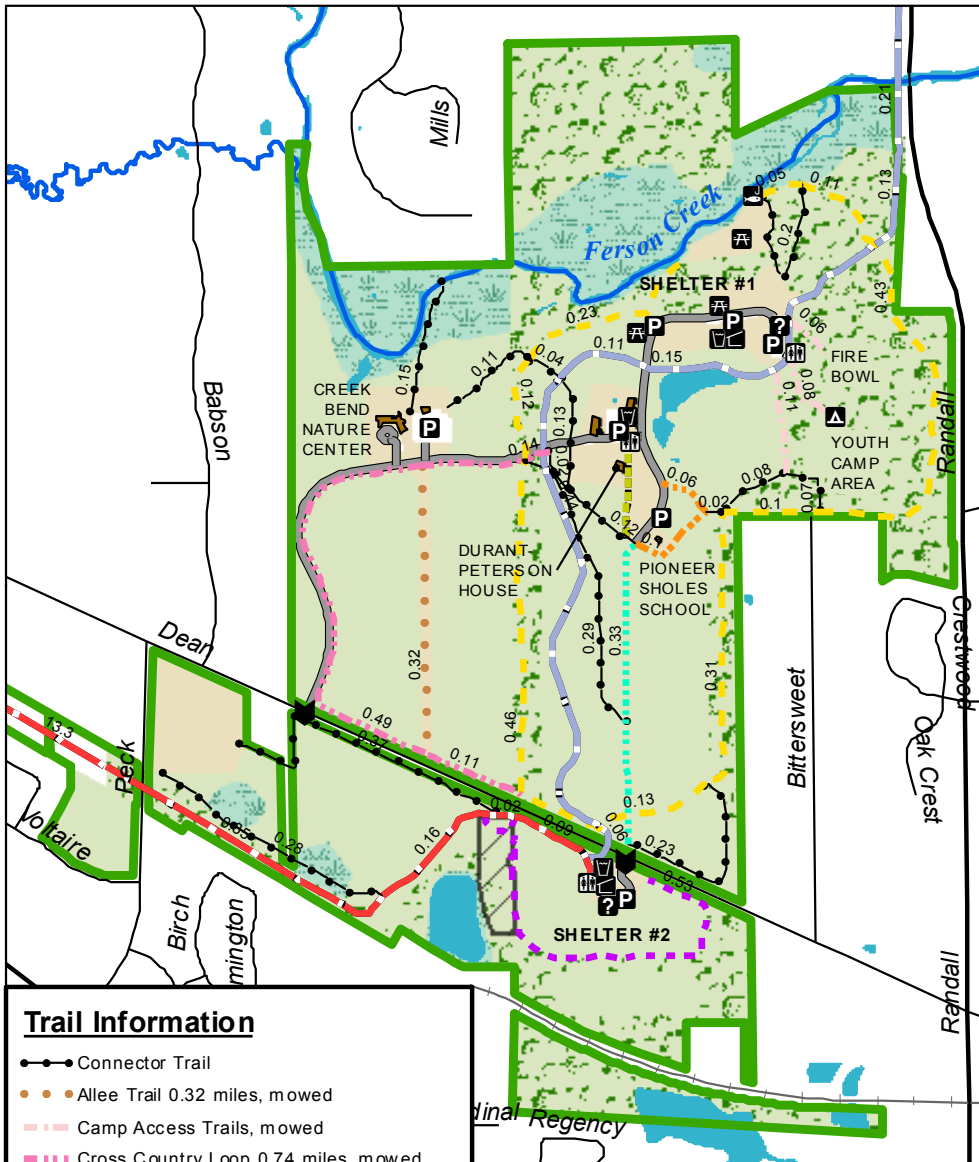
