## RULES & REGULATIONS

- Campgrounds are for recreational camping ONLY.
- Alcohol is not permitted in campgrounds or forest preserves.
- Campground registration is online only as of 2024. Reservations and payment must be made in full before check-in.
- Campground check-in time for all campsites is 3 p.m. Checkout time is 12 p.m.
- If you need to modify or cancel your reservation, it must be completed by 3 p.m. 48 hours prior to the first day of your stay. Cancellations made within this time frame will be credited to your patron account and remain valid until Dec. 31 of the following year. NO REFUNDS will be issued.
- Campgrounds operate on a cashless system, accepting Visa, Mastercard and Discover.
- The minimum age for registration is 18 years old.
- Length of stay can be no more than 14 days within a 21 day period.
- Quiet hours are between 10 p.m. – 8 a.m.
- Camping units may not be left unoccupied for more than 12 hours.
- Campsites listed as ADA accessible are reserved exclusively for individuals with ADA placards.
- Maximum of two vehicles allowed per site (must remain on pad) in addition to camping unit:
  - Maximum of two tents per primitive site.
  - Overflow/visitor vehicles may be parked in primitive parking lot, near restrooms, or near shelters.
  - No parking in or blocking of empty sites is allowed
  - Limit of two vehicles per site, including cargo trailers, utility or boat trailers, etc.
- Guests/visitors must leave area by 10 p.m.
- Vehicles must follow speed limit and directional regulatory signs throughout campgrounds.
  - Driving or parking on grass at any time is prohibited. Speed limit is 5mph.
  - No solicitation, peddling of wares, vending or advertisement on campgrounds.
- See campground office for firewood purchase between 9 a.m. and 9 p.m.
- Fires allowed in designated areas ONLY:
  - Nothing but wood may be burned in designated fire pits (NO garbage).
  - NO cutting or collecting of trees or shrubs for firewood.
- NO motorized vehicles on trails. Including, but not limited to:
  - ATVs, motorcycles, skateboards, etc.
  - Class 1 and Class 2 e-bikes are allowed.

- Pets must be leashed and cleaned up after.
- Please keep door mats off the grass.
- Clothes line and/or hanging laundry out to dry is prohibited.
- NO motorized units on pond.
- NO blow-up bouncy houses, slides, inflatable pools or hot tubs, outside showers, piñatas, DJs, bands, or loud music is allowed.
- Campers must be in a tent, recreational vehicle, or vehicle with camping conversion, as sleeping in vehicles is prohibited.
- Pads must be used under stabilizers on asphalt and aggregate sites.
- Camping units must pull into pull through sites from proper direction. Backing units into site or facing units the wrong direction is prohibited.
- NO U-turns, even for dump facilities.
- Please follow all proper Dump Station rules and procedures (camping units waste hose MUST be used.) Dumping procedures are posted at stations.

**As a permit holder, you agree to abide by all rules and regulations, as well as all Forest Preserve District ordinances, administrative orders and state statutes. Failure to comply, or falsifying application information, may result in a fine or revocation of your permit without refund.**
