GENEVA, IL — Learn how to quickly sketch animals during “Drawing from Life: Local Wildlife” class presented by the Forest Preserve District of Kane County, on Saturday, March 14, from 1-3 p.m.

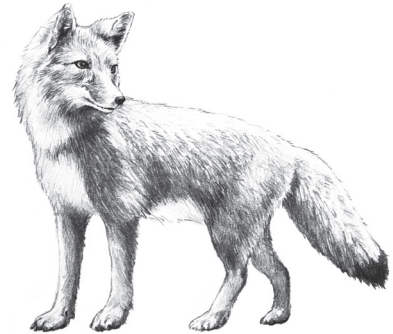
