GENEVA, IL — What can bones tell us about the animal that left them behind? Amazingly enough, a creature’s skeletal system holds a vast number of clues about its life. By understanding and leveraging these signs, we can deduce an animal’s age, diet, and behavior — true wildlife forensics!
