Trail resurfacing work prompts Fox River Trail closures in Carpentersville

GENEVA, IL — The Fox River Trail will have intermittent closures July 21-23, at the intersection of Williams Road and Bolz Road in Carpentersville.

This short section of trail will be resurfaced by KDOT as part of the Longmeadow Bridge construction and trail connection. There will be a gravel bypass for the work area, but trail users should use caution in the work zone and consider walking their bicycle through the intersection.

The trail is expected to reopen on Saturday, July 24. Signs will be posted at the site to notify trail users. The Forest Preserve District asks trail users to use caution and be mindful of the possibility of equipment on or around the trail.
