GENEVA, IL — Learn how to find and document Kane County’s biggest trees at the Forest Preserve District of Kane County’s Big Tree Program.

This program encourages citizens to appreciate, record and report the largest native trees in the county.

The Big Program will begin with classroom instruction covering tree measurement techniques, and the protocol for nominating trees in the program. After instruction, the class will practice measuring trees outdoors.
