Forest Preserve District naturalists will cover trail etiquette for dog-walkers while providing a unique opportunity to socialize your dog. We'll also have fun identifying some of the plants, animals, tracks and trails that we come across.

- 3) **Sunday, Aug. 26;** 9-10 a.m. at Muirhead Springs Forest Preserve, located at 42W855 Bahr Rd., Hampshire.

Note: All dogs must have current vaccinations for rabies, distemper and parvovirus. Only one dog per participant. Pets must be leashed at all times.
