**Blackberry Maples and Rutland Forest Preserves
will be closed for resurfacing, Aug. 27**

GENEVA, IL — The roadways and parking lots at both Blackberry Maples Forest Preserve and Rutland Forest Preserve will be closed for a chip seal resurfacing project on Saturday, Aug. 27.

Contractor AC Pavement will lay a fresh layer of tar and rock chips on the asphalt. The preserves will be closed during this time, and both site locations are expected to reopen on Sunday, Aug. 28. Signs will be posted at both project sites, to alert preserve users of the project.
