Seniors invited on guided forest preserve walks, this summer

GENEVA, IL — Seniors are invited on leisurely, guided strolls through natural areas in the Kane County forest preserves.

Each month, Forest Preserve District of Kane County naturalists lead a stroll, as part of our “Senior Stroll” program series. Along the way, attendees will learn about the natural and cultural history of the area. Senior Stroll programs last about an hour, with social time and refreshments following the walk. These nature programs are free. Registration is not required.

The summer Senior Stroll series will start on Thursday, June 6, from 10 a.m. - noon. This stroll will be held at Johnson’s Mound Forest Preserve, located at 41W600 Hughes Rd., Elburn.

The July Senior Stroll will move to Pingree Grove Forest Preserve, located at 14N187 US Rte. 20, Hampshire. This program is on Thursday, July 11, from 10 a.m. - noon.

The August Senior Stroll program will take place at Dick Young Forest Preserve, located at 39W115 Main St., Batavia. This program is on Thursday, August 1, from 10 a.m. - noon.

The September Senior Stroll program will meet at LeRoy Oakes Forest Preserve, located at 37W700 Dean St., St. Charles. This program is on Thursday, September 5, from 10 a.m. - noon.
