**Forest Preserve District launches online reservations for shelters**

GENEVA, IL — Are you planning a family gathering, celebration, or small special event and looking for the perfect spot? The Forest Preserve District of Kane County now offers a convenient way to reserve shelters online.

Reservations can be made up to one year in advance but no later than seven days before an event. Shelters are available to rent on a first-come, first-served basis and are categorized geographically and by shelter size. Small shelters (capacity of up to 50 people) are \$35 per day for Kane County residents and \$50 for non-residents. Large shelters (capacity of 51-100 people) are \$50 per day for Kane County residents and \$75 for non-residents.

To check availability and to reserve a shelter online, visit <https://kaneforest.com/shelter-rental>. Click on the shelter you are interested in reserving and then on the green “Reserve Shelter” button. If you do not have an account, you must create one to reserve a shelter. Select a location, date and time of the rental, then pay to complete the reservation.

If you’d like to make a reservation for a non-profit organization, business, or special event, please call the Forest Preserve District reservation line at 630-232-1242. This type of reservation may require paperwork and could involve modified pricing. The District does not provide refunds, regardless of weather or event cancellation.
