It's all about snakes at our June 13 nature program

GENEVA, IL — Join us for a fun “snake safari” as we look for native snakes at beautiful Dick Young Forest Preserve in Batavia.

First, we’ll learn about snake identification, then we’ll head out into the field to look for some local examples. This program will cover snakes’ lifestyles, including what they eat, how they eat and where they hang out. A naturalist will demonstrate different methods used in snake research, and will address some misconceptions people have about these reptiles.

“Snake Search” takes place on Sunday, June 13, from 9:30-10:30 a.m. at Dick Young Forest Preserve. We’ll meet at the Nelson Lake Road entrance, located at 2S326 Nelson Lake Road, Batavia.
